For any Artificial Insemination (AI) applications, including semen transportation, Section 5 MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED by a veterinary surgeon; and
provide receipt of payment.

Submission of this application does not guarantee approval. Applications may be deferred for further investigation, interview or for any other reason at the QRIC's discretion. Failure to submit any of the supporting information will result in your application not being considered. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- A stud inspection will be completed prior to this application being approved. This will be arranged after a correctly submitted application has been received.
- Form R285B-1 must be completed and lodged with the QRIC <u>prior</u> to any embryo transfer procedure being performed.
- Form R285B-2 must be completed and lodged with the QRIC <u>within 7 days</u> of any embryo transfer procedure being performed.
- Form R275-A must be completed and lodged with the QRIC <u>no later than 31 March</u> following the breeding season, notifying the names of all mares served, the dates of first and last service, the method of service (hand, paddock, artificial insemination or semen transport) and the pregnancy result.
- Under the Queensland Veterinary Surgeons Act 1936, artificial insemination of horses is a veterinary speciality and
 as such, Al <u>must be</u> performed by a veterinary surgeon when performed in Queensland. This includes the
 collection of semen from a stallion.
- If the stallion(s) will be serving mares by artificial insemination either on farm or by semen transportation, please ensure that a registered veterinary surgeon completes section 5.
