

GREYHOUND STUDMASTERS LICENCE APPLICATION

This Licence permits the holder to carry out the duties of a Studmaster in connection with a registered Sire and to rear, break in or pre-train any Greyhound.

Applicants must have attained the age of 18 years to obtain a Studmasters licence.

□ Colour Photograph:

Please provide a "Licence Style" colour photograph such as a passport photo (upper body shot including your shoulders and head). Please note QRIC **CANNOT** accept a scanned/photocopy of your actual Passport or Drivers Licence as your photograph.

☐ Statutory Declaration:

An original, Justice of the Peace witnessed QRIC Statutory Declaration must be Posted to the QRIC

- 3. I will abide by the Rules of Racing and any lawful direction issued by a steward or authorised officer of the QRIC. I understand that disciplinary action may be taken against me, including revocation of my licence, if I do not abide by the standards of the QRIC, the Rules of Racing or a lawful direction issued by a steward or authorised officer of the QRIC.
- 4. I am not currently subject to any disciplinary action initiated by any other Principal Racing Authority (PRA) in Australia or New Zealand. I will immediately inform the QRIC should any other PRA initiate disciplinary action against me.
- 5. I consent to the QRIC disclosing my personal information to and obtaining information in relation to bets I place (in my own capacity or on behalf or on behalf of any other person) from any entity operating:
 - a) Any totalisator operator in Australia or elsewhere;
 - b) Any bookmaker licensed to operate in Australia or elsewhere, including corporate bookmakers;
 - c) Any betting exchange (licensed or unlicensed) operating in Australia or elsewhere.

I understand that any entity that provides information to the QRIC in compliance with a request made by QRIC does so with my consent and is not breaching the Privacy Act or any other legislation concerning the protection of information concerning my personal affairs, in complying with the request by QRIC.

- 6. I am aware that the QRIC collates personal information relating to me as part of the process of retaining records of all persons licensed by the QRIC. I consent to the QRIC disclosing and requesting personal information concerning my affairs as a licensee to/from:
 - a) Authorised employees and agents of the QRIC;
 - b) Other State and Federal Government departments and agencies;
 - c) Principal Racing Authorities in other states and territories in Australia and elsewhere;
 - d) Your public liability insurer and any agent acting on behalf of your insurer;
 - e) An owner or licensee of a venue at which betting on standard bred races is conducted;
 - f) WorkCover and providers of insurance in the racing industry, and
 - g) I agree to advise the QRIC in writing if I do not consent to my name and contact details being published on the QRIC website.
- 7. I understand that personal information of individuals may be collected or disclosed to third parties by QRIC in connection with the performance of the QRIC's functions and powers.
- 8. All information I have provided in this declaration is true and correct. I understand disciplinary action may be taken against me, including revocation of my licence, if I provide information to the QRIC that is incorrect in any particular.
- 9. I understand that the QRIC may grant me a licence on various conditions and that QRIC has the right to impose additional conditions on my licence, during any licensing period.
- 10. I understand that the QRIC may revoke my licence if I fail to pay debts as and when they fall due.
