Racing participants have accepted the online renewal challenge

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission is very pleased with the uptake of its new licensing and registration online facility RandLE.

More than 1000 participant accounts have now been established in the online system amounting to more than 45 percent of Greyhound and Thoroughbred participants.

The recent licence renewal process has been the first opportunity for Greyhound and

Thoroughbred participants to renew their licences online.

The online system is still in the early stages of develop and the next opportunity will be the capability to apply for licences online and the ability to manage and pay your outstanding debts to the Commission through the online portal.

While hardcopy paper forms are still available, the Commission is encouraging everyone to use the less onerous online system.

The new three year licensing process for trainers announced in July this year is another process benefiting from the move to online processing.

Instead of renewing their licences each year, Queensland trainers will hold a licence for a period of three years before they're required to renew them, all processes that can now occur online.
