Stewards Report: Baylee Nothdurft

Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) Stewards today concluded an inquiry into Nineoneone (T Harrison) falling near the 800m in Race 7, The WWW.BRC.COM.AU 0-65 Handicap (1200m) on 7 October 2019.

Evidence was taken from Jockey T Harrison, Apprentice Jockey B Nothdurft and Trainer T Gollan.

After considering the evidence tendered from both riders and Mr Gollan and viewing the available video footage,

Apprentice Jockey B Nothdurft was charged with careless riding under *AR 131 A rider must not, in the opinion of the Stewards:*

(a) Engage in careless, reckless, improper, incompetent, or foul riding:

The particulars of the charge being that as the rider of Toujours L'amour, near the 800m, he allowed his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear thereby resulting in Nineoneone clipping heels and falling, dislodging its rider. With J Bayliss (Northern Dragon), M Cahill (Missionary Bay) and B Stewart (Pintang Prince), which were following also being dislodged.

After considering further submissions Apprentice Jockey B Nothdurft was found guilty of the charge.

When assessing penalty Stewards considered Apprentice Nothdurft's record with regard to careless riding, his degree of carelessness, the severity of the interference sustained to Nineoneone, which fell and dislodged its rider. Also contributing to the riders of Missionary Bay, Northern Dragon and Pintang Prince being dislodged.

Apprentice Jockey B Nothdurft had his licence to ride in races suspended for 1 Calendar month commencing, following the completion of his current suspension, midnight 12 December 2019 and expiring midnight 11 January 2020.

Apprentice Jockey B Nothdurft was advised of his rights to an Internal Review.
