

Online Harness licence FAQ's

1. What can I do online?

The QRIC online portal now gives you the ability to perform the following online transactions;

- Apply for a licence
- Apply for an upgrade of an existing licence
- Renew your existing licence
- Change your personal details
- Register or update my stable location
- Pay fines

2. How do I get access to my account?

This link is available on the QRIC webpage but you can log on using the following: <u>https://randle.qric.qld.gov.au/</u> - your user name is your email address

3. Do I need to undertake a medical assessment?

If you are applying or renewing your Driver Grade A, B or C licence, you must provide a completed medical assessment form as part of the application.

4. Where do I get the medical assessment form for the doctor to fill out?

The medical assessment form is available on the QRIC website, under Licencing and ownership > Harness > Licensing: <u>https://www.qric.qld.gov.au/licensing-and-ownership/harness/licensing/</u>

This form must be completed before renewing your licence. You must attach the document as a PDF or JPG file to your online application.

5. What happens after I submit an application?

Your documents are verified and depending on the licence type, recommendations, clearances from other bodies and/or premise inspections are carried out. Once everything is gathered, your application is progressed for approval and you are advised of the decision
