Stewards Report: Anna Bakos and Mandy Radecker

Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) Stewards today concluded an inquiry into a complaint lodged regarding the conduct and behaviour of apprentice jockey Anna Bakos and licensed trackwork rider Mandy Radecker during trackwork at Deagon Racecourse on the 4th of December 2020.

After considering all the evidence, Stewards issued both parties with a charge under the provisions of AR 228(b) which reads:

A person must not engage in misconduct, improper conduct or unseemly behaviour.

The particulars of the two charges being:

1. Anna Bakos – Whilst conducting trackwork duties at Deagon Racecourse on the 4th of December 2020, used foul and improper language towards Mandy Radecker and again acted improperly by engaging in a physical altercation with Mandy Radecker in the vicinity of the tie-up stalls.
2. Mandy Radecker- Whilst conducting trackwork duties at Deagon Racecourse on the 4th of December 2020, acted improperly by engaging in a physical altercation with Anna Bakos in the vicinity of the tie-up stalls.

Both parties pleaded guilty to their respective charge and made submissions in relation to penalty.

After considering the submissions, Stewards issued the following penalties:

1. Anna Bakos - \$2000 Fine, \$1000 of which is wholly suspended for a period of two years under AR283(5).
2. Mandy Radecker - \$2000 Fine, \$1000 of which is wholly suspended for a period of two years under AR283(5).

Both parties were advised of their rights to an internal review into the decision.
