Stewards of the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission today concluded an inquiry into analyst's findings that the prohibited substance Arsenic was detected in a post-race urine sample collected from the greyhound Jackie's Star when it competed and won at the Ipswich Greyhound Racing Club on 24 September 2021.

The sample was analysed at the Racing Science Centre, with the results confirming the presence of Arsenic at a level in excess of the permitted threshold pursuant to the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.

The sample was then sent to Racing Analytical Services Limited for confirmatory analysis, with the results of that analysis confirming the presence of Arsenic at a level below the permitted threshold pursuant to the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.

After considering all of the evidence, Stewards determined that no further action be taken in respect of the matter.

Stewards cautioned Mr Topping in respect of the levels of Arsenic present in the post-race urine sample collected from Jackie's Star and further advised him to take greater care to avoid any further potential breaches in respect of exceeding the permitted threshold.
