Stewards of the Queensland Racing Integrity Commission today concluded an inquiry into analyst's findings that Dexamethasone was detected in a post-race urine sample collected from the greyhound No Swap Back when it competed and won at the Brisbane Greyhound Racing Club on 14 October 2021.

The sample was analysed at the Racing Science Centre with the results confirming the presence of Dexamethasone, being a prohibited substance pursuant to the Greyhounds Australasia Rules.

The sample was then sent to Racing Analytical Services Limited for confirmatory analysis, with the results of that analysis being that Dexamethasone was not detected in the sample.

After considering all of the evidence, Stewards determined that no further action be taken in respect of the matter.
