Stewards Report: Apprentice Lilli Barr

Queensland Racing Integrity Commission((QRIC) Stewards today concluded an inquiry into an incident whereby Jockey Cecily Eaton was dislodged from her mount MANDALONG NERO near the 200m in Race 4 the SJG PLUMBING & DRAINAGE QTIS MAIDEN PLATE over 1350M at Warwick on the 19 December 2021.

After reviewing the patrol footage and taking evidence from the riders involved as well as submissions from Trainers Mr L Ross, Mr T Sears and Senior rider Mr J Byrne it was determined that leaving the 200m Apprentice L Barr (IMBATIDO) did, under riding, permit her mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of MANDALONG NERO (C Eaton) which consequently clipped that runner's heels, blundered and dislodged its rider.

Apprentice Barr was subsequently found guilty of careless riding under the provisions of AR 131(a) and her licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of fifteen (15) days to commence 18 February 2022 up to and including 4 March 2022.

In determining penalty Stewards considered the degree of carelessness and interference, Apprentice Barr's limited riding experience, her forthright evidence and excellent record in relation to the rule.

Apprentice Barr was advised of her rights to an internal review.
